2021 USA Archery JOAD Indoor Nationals FORMAT AND RULES



DIVISIONS AND CLASSES:

Recurve Men and Women – Junior, Cadet, Cub, Bowman
Compound Men and Women – Junior, Cadet, Cub, Bowman
Barebow Men and Women – Junior, Cadet, Cub, Bowman
Barebow, by definition, is a recurve bow without sights or other accessories.

ELIGIBILITY:

JOAD Indoor Nationals is <u>not</u> open to non-U.S. citizens.

All participants shall be registered and compete in a JOAD State Championships.

All participants shall be a current member of USA Archery.

All participants shall be a member of a USAA Archery JOAD, College or Adult/JOAAD club

AGE CLASSES:

Participants may compete as

"Bowman" through the calendar year of their 12th birthday.

"Cub" through the calendar year of their 14th birthday.

"Cadet" through the calendar year of their 17th birthday.

"Junior" through the calendar year of their 20th birthday.

FORMAT:

Recurve/Barebow – One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

Juniors and Cadets - 40cm target face; outer 10 ring scoring

Cubs and Bowmen – 60cm target face; outer 10 ring scoring – no target choice

Compound – One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

All Classes – 40cm target face; inner 10 ring scoring

TARGET FACES:

40cm; 10-ring

40cm; Vertical Recurve 40cm; Vertical Compound

Recurve/Barebow – Juniors and Cadets may choose their target face*.

Compound - All age classes may choose their target face*.

Recurve/Barebow – Bowman and Cub will shoot a 60cm, 10-ring face.

*Archers who have a choice between a 40cm single-spot and a vertical 3-spot target face must use the same style target face for the entire tournament.

LOCATION INDOOR LIMITATION:

An archer may participate at only one location for this competition. An archer is considered a participant after one arrow is shot.

WHICH LOCATION?

Participants may compete at only one of the locations for this event noted on the USA Archery website.

ENTERING MORE THAN ONE DIVISION:

An archer may compete in more than one division (i.e. Compound or Recurve), but may not compete in more than one class (i.e. Junior or Cadet). <u>Separate fees and a separate</u> registration is required for each category (i.e. Recurve Cadet Men or Compound Cadet

<u>Men) in which an archer intends to shoot. The archer must also shoot an</u> additional round for each entry.

DRESS CODE:

USA Archery dress code will be strictly enforced throughout the event, at all locations. Please review the dress code prior to the event at www.usarchery.org.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE:

Official practice will be 3 ends prior to scoring for every session.

AWARDS:

National awards will be mailed from the USA Archery national office after final results from all locations are verified and combined.

State awards are managed by the state event director.

CONFIRMATION:

Be sure to review your registration confirmation for accuracy; once scoring has started, your category may not be changed.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

Be sure to check with the event organizer/website for specific safety protocols that will be in place.

COACHES DURING PRACTICE AND COMPETITION:

Personal coaches are restricted to the spectator area at all times.

ARCHERS' AREA SEATING:

Credentialed persons assisting the tournament officials may sit in the archers' area.

PHOTOGRAPHERS:

Photographers will be credentialed by the Host Venue, and are bound by the USA Archery media policy. Please send questions and/or credentialing requests to media@usarchery.org.

DRUG TESTING:

Any archer may be subject to unannounced drug testing. Refusal to test may lead to disqualification.

USAT QUALIFICATION:

JOAD Indoor Nationals not a USAT qualifier.

SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY -

1ST QUARTER USA ARCHERY VIRTUAL TOURNAMENT:

Club Leaders = Register in advance and submit the first 30 arrows of a designated round to the Virtual event.
