Waiver, release of liability, and assumption of risk

The following statements are a release of liability for minor child participating in training and competition with Kentucky Elite Archery:

- I understand the nature of archery in general and attest that my child is both physically and mentally capable, and even with adaptive equipment, they are capable of participating safely and independently in archery.
- I release Kentucky Elite Archery, its coaching staff, or volunteers operating on behalf of Kentucky Elite Archery from liability for injury or harm that may occur. This release extends to my dependent, even if participating in the adaptive archer program.
- Para-athletes - I am aware that archery may be conducted in facilities or ranges open to the public during the training or competition. I understand that my para-athlete may not have at some events access to ADA compliant ranges.
- I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe at practices or at events, I will immediately discontinue further participation in archery.
- I FULLY UNDERSTAND that:
 - Archery involves inherent and other risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death (referred to as "Risks").
 - Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in archery, the conditions in which archery takes place and/or the negligence of others.
 - There are other risks or social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time but may arise in connection with my participation in archery.
 - I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the releases or others; FOR any liabilities, losses, costs, and/or damages I or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in archery.
- I, for myself, and on behalf of my child/children, family members, or others who attend to watch my child compete, I do release, discharge, covenant to not sue, agree to hold harmless, and waive all claims related to Kentucky Elite Archery, its administrators, directors, coaches, volunteers, employees, other archers or parents, sponsors, advertisers, and any other owner or lessor of premises or ranges on which archery takes place.
- I release them from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on account caused in or in part by my participation in archery from whatever cause, including without limitation, the negligence of the "releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations, except as the result of gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

- I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the “releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss liability, damage, or cost any may incur as the result of any such claim.

CODE OF CONDUCT

By signing these releases, I agree to be bound by the code of Conduct set up by Kentucky Elite Archery. I understand that my participation, and my minor child, in activities sponsored by KEA is dependent upon my adherence to the programs Code of Conduct, consents and waivers of liability.

Part 1: Parent Code of Conduct

- **I will always promote the importance of honesty, commitment, discipline, and sportsmanship.**
- I will give constructive feedback to my child in private and never be negative about performance.
- I will always focus on my child's best effort and performance and not their scores.
- I will refrain from the use of profanity, showing disrespect, or using language that is negative toward judges, coaches, athletes, or other parents.
- I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, or different ability.
- I will be positive on social media and use respect and integrity in my posts.
- I will never post pictures of others, especially pictures of other children.
- I will share with the Head Coach any behaviors that seems inappropriate by coaches, volunteers, student athletes or others in the program. (Title IX and ADA)
- I recognize that Kentucky Elite and its coaching staff use the NTS or National Training System of the USA Archery Olympic and Paralympic programs. Although it may be different than my own knowledge or style as an archer, I will support and reinforce the technical training taught my child by Certified instructor Trainers of KEA.
- **I will follow the “no parent coaching” rule and refrain from coaching from the stands or sidelines during lessons or competitions.** I will not enter the archery range during a scheduled practice, lesson, or event. (In competition, an athlete may be disqualified in this case.) Reasons Include:
 - Safety, insurance, and liability.
 - **Children are easily distracted, and many are “pleasers” who will often look to parents for approval/disapproval instead of a coach.** We want children focused on safety, shot sequence and fundamentals while on the range rather than on you as a parent/guardian.
- I will follow and ensure that my child/children understand the code of conduct and range safety rules.

Part 2: Archer Code of Conduct

- Rule #1: Have Fun! Every time I pick up a bow my #1 Goal is to have fun!
- Rule #2: Focus on Learning! I will always focus on learning and not winning!
 - *There is never losing, but always learning”.*
- Rule #3: Follow the Rules! I will always follow the range and safety rules.
- Rule #4: Respect My Sport:
 - Being on time.
 - Being a hard worker.
 - Being humble.
 - If I win an award in competition, I will not brag.
 - If my teammate succeeds ahead of me, I will cheer them on.
 - If I do NOT win an award, I WILL NOT hang my head.
 - *WE ALL FALL SHORT! I know my arrows will fall short of their mark. But I will not hang my head. (Romans 3:23).*
 - Instead, I will focus on what I need to do to improve on my next arrow or my next tournament.
 - Take care of my facility and equipment. I will help keep MY training facility clean and looking professional.
- Rule #5: Respect my Coach!
 - I will listen.
 - I will learn.
 - I will lean-on my coach/s
- Rule #6: Respect my Teammates!
 - I will put others before myself.
 - I will be KIND and help others.
 - I will never bully and will always speak up for others.
 - I will respect all others regardless of the color of their skins, what country they are from, whether they are a boy or girls, or if they disabled.
 - I will always be honesty, follow rules, and show good sportsmanship.
 - **I will make sure to tell my coach or my parents if I or one of my teammates is being bullied or needs help.**
